Pool Rules:

- EVERYONE must have their Membership Card and must sign in with the gate guard.
- Abusive or profane language or breach of peace will not be tolerated anywhere on association property.
- The Association is not responsible for the personal property of members, dependents, or guests, which is left, lost, damaged, or stolen on Association property.
- Any Association property willfully damaged by any member or guest will be repaired or replaced at the members or guests' expense.
- Proper attire MUST be worn on the property at all times.
- Pets are not permitted inside the fenced pool area or on the tennis courts.
- Notice of all special events requiring the pool or tennis court closing at other than regular hours will be posted at least 48 hours in advance.
- Facility rules are for the benefit of all members and guests; it is the responsibility of each member to abide by all rules.
- Children under the age of 12 must be under the direct supervision of someone 16 years or older while on association property
- Pool Safety:
- The use of the pool is at your own risk. The Association does not monitor the vaccination records of individuals who use the pool nor does the Association provide any increased sanitization procedures against the COVID-19 virus.
- Everyone must leave the pool in the event of an emergency. The signal for this is three (3) blasts of the lifeguard's whistle. There will be emergency drills throughout the season. Children under the age of 12 must be under the direct supervision of someone 16 years old or over while on the property.
- All children 12 to 15, not accompanied by an adult, may be required

to pass a designated swim test.

- Children under the age of 12 who are attending swim team practice are not allowed on the facility grounds until fifteen (15) minutes before their scheduled swim practice.
- -The swimming pool will be used only during scheduled hours when lifeguards are on duty.
 - The lifeguards have the authority to close the pool at anytime, in consideration of the health and safety of the members. (Cold weather, rain, electrical storms, an equipment malfunction, etc.)
 - Gum is not allowed inside the pool fenced-in areas.
 - Bikes, skate-boards, and skates of any kind are not allowed.
 - Dunking, pushing, running and all forms of horseplay are prohibited.
 - APPROVED life jackets, water wings and ring vests may be worn only by very small children in the wading pool and in the shallow end of the large pool when accompanied and supervised by an adult.
 - Inner tubes are not permitted in the pool area.
 - If small non-swimming children are allowed in the pool, the parents must accompany them in the water. The children must remain in the shallow roped off area of the pool.
 - Throwing of balls, frisbees, diving rings or other objects within the fenced pool area is absolutely prohibited.
 - Water balloons and water guns are prohibited within the fenced pool area.
 - A child rest period will be called by the lifeguards for 15 minutes at a quarter to the hour. Only adults (16 years of age and older) may use the pool during this time. Exceptions: babies held by a parent.
 - Any swimmer participating in extensive swimming will be cautioned by the lifeguard and may be required to discontinue such practice for a reasonable rest period.

- Non-swimmers are prohibited in the diving well.
- Swimmers jumping/diving off the diving boards may not jump or dive to the side. They must go straight off the end of the diving boards.
- Only one person is permitted on each diving
 board or ladder at a time.
 Do not hang onto the
 edge or end of the diving boards.
- After jumping/diving into the water, the swimmer should swim directly to an exit before the next jump/dive is allowed.
- Do not hang on the dividing ropes, lane lines, the fill pipe or the lifeguard stands.
- Baby carriages and wheelchairs are the only wheeled vehicles allowed in the fenced pool area.
- Swim fins, snorkels, and face masks are not allowed inside the fenced pool area.
- Unless an emergency arises, all conversations with the lifeguards should be restricted to off duty time.
- Only authorized lifeguard personnel are allowed to be in the lifeguard stands/ stations.
 - The baby pool is for the use of children age five (5) and under only, and only with the direct supervision of a responsible person, age 16 or older. Older children are not permitted in this pool.
 - The lifeguards and manager are fully authorized to enforce all rules and regulations and may temporarily suspend violators as they deem necessary.
